Subject(s) of the lesson

Regular -AR verb conjugation in the present tense.

Prerequisite Knowledge:

Students need to know what a verb is and what it means to conjugate a verb. They will need to recall conjugation from chapter 1 and vocabulary from this chapter.

Content:

Students will learn about regular –AR verbs in the present tense and how to conjugate them. –AR verbs are one out of three different types of verbs students will encounter when learning Spanish. –AR verbs are the first type of verbs that students learn how to conjugate and are among the easiest to learn.

1. Students will be able to conjugate regular –AR verbs
2. Students will be able to identify subject pronouns
3. Students will be able to match verbs with the correct English meaning

How will you teach the content?

Students will watch a brief instructional video that will teach them how to conjugate regular –AR verbs. The video will explain the different parts of a verb and how to conjugate it properly. The students will be able to watch the video multiple times if need be and will also be shown a video with a short song to help them remember the endings.
