Subject(s) of the lesson:

Review of unit with AR verbs, conjugation, subject pronouns and answering questions

Prerequisite Knowledge:

Students will need to recall conjugation for regular AR verbs, Spanish pronouns, question words and how to answer questions. All of this information was covered throughout the unit.

Content

Students will play jeopardy to review all the information learned in the unit about regular AR verbs, endings, subject pronouns and how to answer questions.

List the objectives for this lesson.

1. Students will be able to conjugate regular AR Verbs
2. Students will be able to identify Spanish subject pronouns compared with English pronouns
3. Students will be able to answer questions using correct conjugation and vocabulary

How will you teach the content?

Students have spent the past 3 lessons, plus many more, on this topic. Students will be reminded that they need to know all the material we have previously learned to play jeopardy. They will be reminded of the rules, that if they get the answer correct, they will earn points, and if it's incorrect they will lose points. Students will be split into teams to play the game, depending on the size of the class they will be in 2 or 3 teams.
